We welcome and uplift all BIPOC artists, including those who identify as LGBTQIA+ and who identify as disabled. As an artistic home for artists of all disciplines, New Victory LabWorks explores, devises and reimagines what theater for families can be.

- Bio: Describe yourself professionally (ie: artistic work experience, education/training), and include any past or planned presentations of your work, including dates and venues. (*250 words max*)
- Why are you interested in creating work for kids and family audiences? (*250 words max*)
- Is there a specific target audience or age group you are interested in creating work for? If so, please specify. (*For example: 3rd-6th graders, D/deaf or Hard of Hearing audiences, Families at Home*)

Please include all available materials. The artistic sample may be family-focused, but it doesn't need to be. We understand that all of the work you create may not be intended for young audiences and families. Include materials that best demonstrate your artistic voice.

- Photo documentation
- Script (PDF)
- Design renderings (PDF)
- Music/Audio
- Resumes or bios of artists/collaborators involved in the project (PDF)
