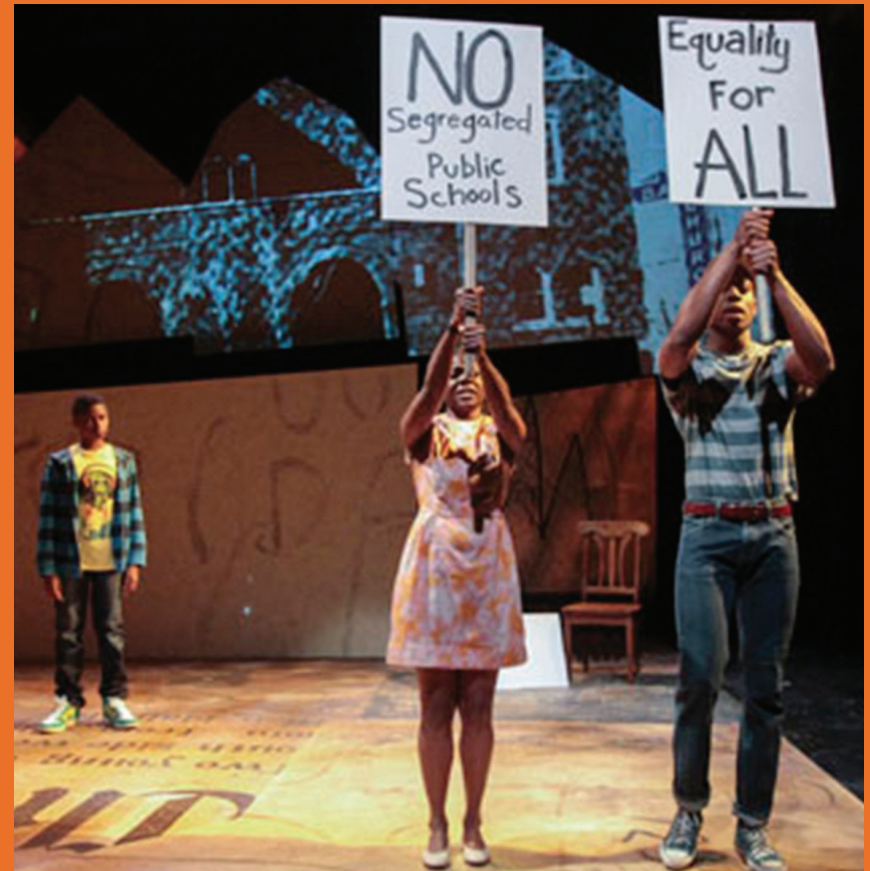

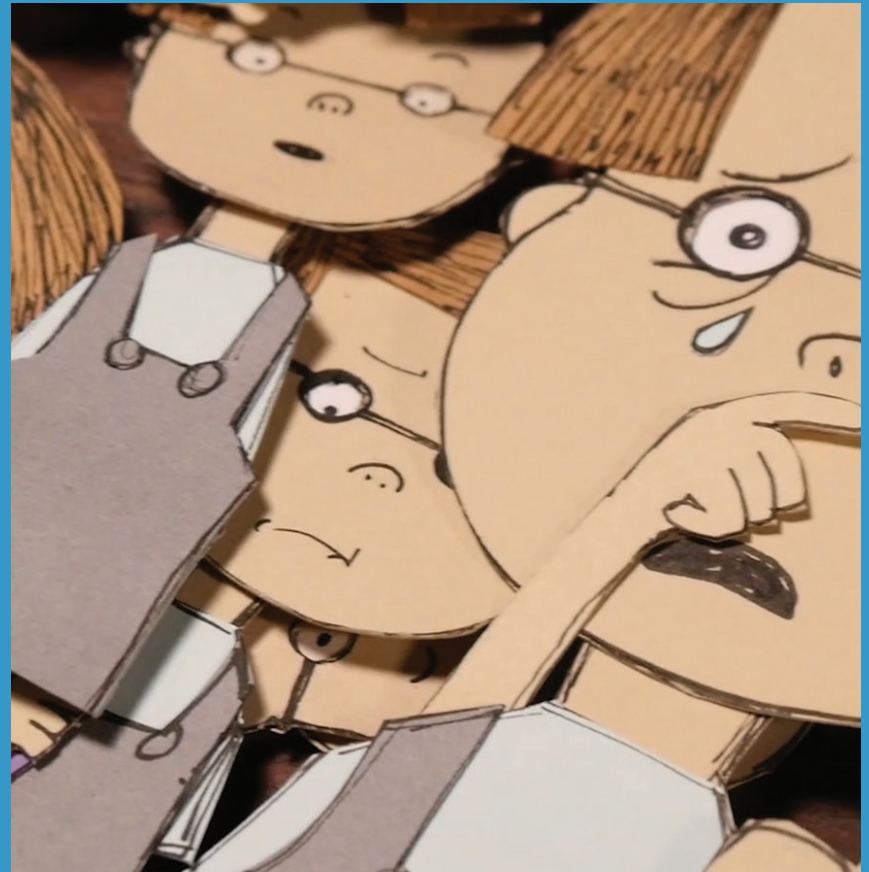
Leonardo and Sam

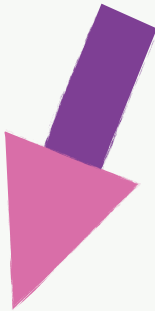
